

Insurance For FRA Races

Races that are licenced by the FRA benefit from the insurance that UK Athletics have put in place for athletics events. Clubs that are affiliated to England Athletics are covered for their own club events, but UK Athletics have now made it clear that for the cover to apply, a licence is required for all events that:

- have 150 or more participants, or
- charge for entry, or
- have runners not members of the organising club taking part

A copy of the current insurer's letter confirming that UK Athletics cover is in place can be found on the UK Athletics website and on the FRA website 'Documents' pages, or on request from the FRA Secretary.

Evidence that a race is licenced by the FRA and therefore benefits from this insurance can be found in the individual race listings on the FRA website. Race organisers should also be displaying a copy of their race licence which they can download from the FRA website, at their race.

If an organiser needs to provide evidence of insurance cover e.g. for a landowner, they should use their race licence together with a copy of the insurer's letter.
